



Jim Stanard - *Color Outside The Lines*

Singer-songwriter Jim Stanard will release his sophomore album, ***Color Outside The Lines***, in October. Teaming up again with Grammy-nominated hitmaker and producer Kip Winger and Afghan Whigs guitarist Jon Skibic, this effort also features the legendary **Peter Yarrow** (of Peter, Paul & Mary) and his daughter **Bethany Yarrow** on two songs. The album will be released on CD, digital, and vinyl LP, and will be accompanied by four music videos, led by the 1st single, "Home."

Color Outside The Lines once again showcases the Colorado/Florida-based troubadour's distinctive songcraft, vivid storytelling and unmistakably authentic voice—the same qualities that made listeners and critics take notice of his acclaimed 2018 debut *Bucket List*.

1. **Home** (3:22) - featuring Bethany and Peter Yarrow - The USA is a nation of immigrants, and I believe that's a key part of why it's such a wonderful country.
2. **Same River** (3:46) You can't step into exactly the same river twice, because it's different water than before; you can't exactly recreate an old relationship, because people change, at least a little.
3. **Witness Protection** (2:53) I can't quit you by myself – I need help.
4. **One Time In A Row** (2:57) You only need to find one true love – being fortunate one time is enough.
5. **Arkansas** (3:10) featuring Bethany and Peter Yarrow - Story of a fictional Sheriff set in the historical massacre in Elaine, AR, 1919 – leaders (and all people) must take responsibility for the consequences of their actions.
6. **Fake News** (3:05) Everyone knows she's cheating on him, but he doesn't believe it.
7. **Color Outside The Lines** (3:42) It can be hard to regain a childlike sense of freedom and creativity – we are trained to conform.
8. **When My Truck** (3:08) My self-driving truck will be smarter than I was – it wouldn't have let you go.
9. **Each Other's Minds** (3:29) A relationship needs communication.
10. **The Opium Wars** (4:09) The Opium Wars between Britain and China in the mid-1800's lead to China's "century of humiliation." The wars with, and over, drugs have never stopped.
11. **Soft And Gentle Smile** (2:21) Her smile is the same today as it was the day we met.
